EASTERTIDE - We continue our keeping of the great fifty days of Easter this morning with the 'Third Sunday of Easter. We continue to make "Alleluia" our song and rejoice in the good news of the resurrection, as we remember our call to share the risen life of Jesus. In the gospel we hear the story of the third encounter of Jesus with his disciples following his resurrection, the miraculous catch of the one hundred and fifty three fish, and the restoration of Peter with Jesus call to him to 'feed my sheep'. We ask for grace in our lives today to receive the Lord's forgiveness and so be equipped for the work he gives us to do.

THIS MORNING - We welcome The Archdeacon of Westmorland and Furness, The Venerable Vernon Ross to preach at the Parish Eucharist. We hold Vernon, his family, and his ministry in the Diocese and county in our prayers.

ORGAN - The contractors have now taken away a large part of our organ "innards" for cleaning, renovating and rebuilding at their premises in Leeds. We do not have a precise date for how long this will take. Other, larger parts are stored in the block of pews adjacent to the north aisle and work will take place on these later. Do take a look inside the organ casing to see what also has to be removed and serviced. Over 1,000 pipes remain... Meanwhile, a temporary electronic organ has been installed at the front of church on the south wall and this will lead the service over the summer months.

CHURCH CLOSING - During these weeks our insurers (Ecclesiastical) will only maintain their cover of those organ parts remaining if the church is locked when there is nobody inside so, as a normal rule, until further notice, the church will be closed except during services. Access to the Office (when open) will be by the side door.

LUNCH TIME CONCERT - Our season began wonderfully with an attractive programme by two pianists in perfect harmony -Charles Edmondson & Stephen Hitchcock.
