**First Reading** - Genesis 37: 1-4, 12-28

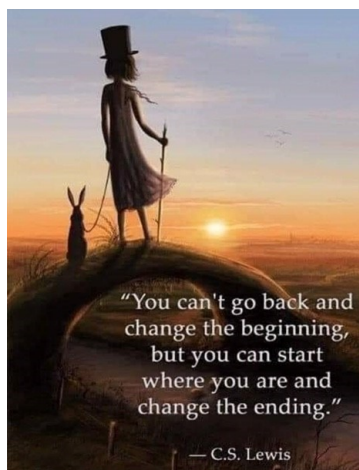
**Second Reading** - Romans 10: 5-15
