John 2.1-11 The Wedding in Cana

1 Two days after Jesus called Philip and Nathaniel there was a wedding in the town of Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, 2 and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding.

3 When the wine had given out, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no wine left."

4 "You must not tell me what to do," Jesus replied. "My time has not yet come."

5 Jesus' mother then told the servants,

"Do whatever he tells you."

6 The Jews have rules about ritual washing, and for this purpose six stone water jars were there, each one large enough to hold between twenty and thirty gallons. 7 Jesus said to the servants, "Fill these jars with water." They filled them to the brim, 8 and then he told them, "Now draw some water out and take it to the man in charge of the feast."

They took him the water, 9 which now had turned into wine, and he tasted it. He did not know where this wine had come from (but, of course, the servants who had drawn out the water knew); so he called the bridegroom 10 and said to him, "Everyone else serves the best wine first, and after the guests have drunk a lot, he serves the ordinary wine. But you have kept the best wine until now!"

11 Jesus performed this first miracle in Cana in Galilee; there he revealed his glory, and his disciples believed in him.

12 After this, Jesus and his mother, brothers, and disciples went to Capernaum and stayed there a few days.

God was a God of Signs and Wonders before Jesus came to earth. The term is first mentioned in Exodus 7.3 when God said to Moses: "I'm going to put Pharaoh s back up, and follow it up by filling Egypt with signs and wonders." (Message)

Signs and Wonders are mentioned 31 times in the bible. They happen when the future conditions of the Kingdom of God break out now on earth. They give us a hint as to what the new heaven on earth might be like: no more pain, no more suffering, no more illness, no shortage, blessings abounding...

Through these miracles, that John called 'signs,' Jesus revealed who he was: the God of signs and wonders come to earth. He revealed God's kingdom through these signs and wonders. The Kingdom is already breaking out, but not yet fully come.

In the story of the wedding, Jesus demonstrates in vivid real-time 3D video technicolour just how abundant the extraordinary conditions of the kingdom he came to establish are.

120-180 **gallons** of the best wine anyone had ever tasted! That must have been some wedding reception!

We tend towards the default way of thinking and acting: that these signs and wonders were for then.

But Jesus taught his disciples to 'do' the same things he did: heal the sick, cast out demons, correct injustices,

feed the hungry. In fact he said his followers would do even greater things even than he did. (Jn 14.12)

None of us has the power or ability to do any of these things, without the power of the same Spirit who empowered Jesus.

What's the difference? Jesus listened to his Father completely, trusted totally, and obeyed absolutely. He wasn't impressed by what human beings thought of him. To put it in other words, he had complete confidence in his identity as God-on-earth.

I did my PhD on Columba, who brought the faith from Ireland into Britain in the 6th century. He evangelised with the help of signs and wonders. (My book, Prophecy, Miracles, Angels and Heavenly Light? tells the story.) Wesley preached, with signs and wonders following in the 18th century, etc.

Signs and Wonders have never stopped appearing when people have ministered with confidence in God rather than in their own ability.

The tragedy is, these have all too often been left to the crackpot fringes of church life, instead of being the toolkit right at the heart of our daily practice as followers of Jesus, where today's collect puts them!!

We also can have confidence that Jesus calls us to follow him, in every way. Our identity is in Christ...
