**CHURCHWARDEN & DEPUTY CHURCHWARDEN**

At our meeting on 25<sup>th</sup> April after the morning service, we  
hope to elect two churchwardens. Currently, only Mike Hill  
has agreed to stand. Is anyone willing to share this job with  
him? The wardens are legally responsible for the fabric and  
belongings of the church and to assist the incumbent in the  
running of the church. It is a fascinating position. We  
traditionally also appoint one or two deputy wardens to  
share responsibilities – we have no volunteers so far. Please  
consider whether you could share in the running of the  
church and shaping its future. Please talk to Mike or  
Margaret about both jobs.

The **WORSHIP COMMITTEE** has been struggling as to how  
best we can make our worship meaningful during this time  
of partial lockdown. We very much look forward to the  
time when we can all return to singing in our services, and  
particularly the return of our 'full' choir. We have 9 people  
waiting in the wings for when they can return, but it is  
unlikely to be before the 17<sup>th</sup> May at the earliest. The  
official guidance is that "a single small group of singers will  
be allowed to perform ... only where essential to an act of  
communal worship. This should be limited to as few singers  
as possible. Communal singing should not take place and  
strict physical distancing should be observed". We are  
grateful to the two or three members of our original choir  
who have agreed to sing some of our hymns in the  
meantime. We have chosen a pattern whereby one hymn is  
hummed (or, if you prefer, you can just listen to the music  
following the words in the hymn book), two are sung, and  
one is read out against music playing in the background. We  
hope you will find this more meaningful than us all  
humming behind our masks. Any other suggestions are  
welcomed.

As to the music, we are grateful to Charles Edmondson who  
has offered to play on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> services in the month,  
to Joan Oliver who has agreed to play on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, and to  
Jane Dutton who will play the piano for lay-led services.  
Jane has been worshipping with us for over 2 years, and is  
a classically trained musician with a music diploma. She has  
played and led music groups for about 40 years, including  
traditional hymns as well as more modern songs.
