FOR REFLECTION:

"The church can and must act in the world. It should serve the poor, defend human dignity and contribute to social life. But these actions must flow from faith. They cannot replace it. When activity takes precedence over worship, when structures overshadow doctrine, when agreement becomes more important than truth, the church risks losing its identity. It may remain busy, organized and visible but it becomes hollow. A church that celebrates action for its own sake becomes unnecessary. It will not disappear because of persecution. It will fade because it has emptied itself from within. If it simply mirrors the language and categories of the surrounding culture, it ceases to offer an alternative; it becomes a duplicate and a weaker one at that. When the church tries to anticipate the world rather than transform it, when it seeks relevance by adopting standards that do not arise from the Gospel, it gradually loses its supernatural character. It may gain temporary approval but it sacrifices clarity about who it is". - *Benedict XVI.*
